## Grand Forks County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan City of Thompson

**Whereas**, the City of Thompson recognizes the threat that natural, man-made or technological hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

**Whereas**, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce and/or eliminate the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

**Whereas**, an adopted Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

**Whereas**, the City of Thompson participated in the preparation of this plan in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

**Whereas**, adoption of the Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan demonstrates the commitment to hazard mitigation; and

**Now, therefore, be it resolved**, that the City of Thompson adopts the Grand Forks County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan.

# MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

Thompson, North Dakota

Chapter 21  
Resolution No. 1  
Article

WHEREAS, all citizens and property within the City of Thompson are at risk from a wide range of hazards such as, but not limited to, communicable disease, dam failure, drought, flood, hazardous material release, homeland security incident, shortage or outage of critical materials or infrastructure, summer storm, transportation accident, urban fire or structure collapse, wildland/rural fire, and winter weather.

WHEREAS, the City of Thompson pursuant to Section 322, Mitigation Planning, of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, enacted by Section 104 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (P.L. 106-390) and the Interim Final Rule published in the Federal Register on February 26, 2002 at 44 CFR Part 201, is required to have an approved Grand Forks County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan in order to receive future federal disaster mitigation funds.

WHEREAS, a Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan will guide the City of Thompson in making decisions for pre-disaster and post-disaster mitigation projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Thompson hereby adopts the Grand Forks County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan dated May 2009.
